BYLAW 2016-07
A BYLAW TO AMEND THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Osler, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend the Zoning Bylaw as follows:

PART I – PURPOSE

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend Bylaw 2012 – 15, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

1. **Table 6-11 Small Lot Residential** is amended by reducing the Minimum Site Width for from 12 metres to 10 metres, for the following uses:
 - Single detached dwellings
 - Adult day care
 - Residential care facilities
 - Bed and breakfast homes
 - Day care centres and preschools

2. **The Zoning District Map referred to in Section 7 – Maps** is amended by rezoning Parcel A, Plan 102043145 from R3-High Density Residential to R1A – Small Lot Residential as shown on “Schedule A” which is attached to and forms a part of this bylaw.

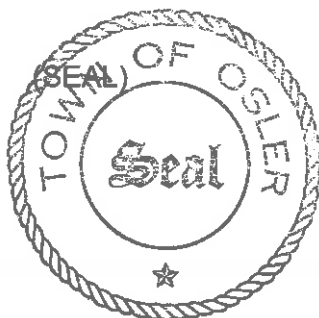
PART II – COMING INTO FORCE AND EFFECT
