TOWN OF OSLER BYLAW 2017-08 A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OSLER TO AMEND TRAFFIC BYLAW 2015-07

The Council of the Town of Osler, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

PART I – PURPOSE

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend the Traffic Bylaw 2015-07, by an addition to Appendix One (Stop Streets).

PART II – GENERAL PROVISIONS

The following is added to Appendix One (Stop Streets) of the Traffic Bylaw No. 2015-07:

On	At the Intersection of	Approaching from the
2 nd Ave	2 nd St	East
2 nd Ave	2 nd St	West
1 st Ave	2 nd St	East
1 st Ave	2 nd St	West

PART III – PENALTY

Any person who contravenes a provision of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and is liable, upon summary conviction, to a penalty as set out in Bylaw 2015-07, the Traffic Bylaw.

PART IV - COMING INTO FORCE AND EFFECT

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the day it is approved by the Council of the Town of Osler.
