PLEASE REMEMBER....

Pet owners should be aware that you **must** adhere to the Animal Control Bylaw. Two sections of note are: **Sec 6(1)** reads "No owner of a cat or dog shall permit the cat or dog to be at large" (you must always have your pet on a leash or within the confines of your yard.); and, **Sec 10(1)** states "If a cat or dog defecates on any public or private property, other than property belonging to the pet owner, **the owner** of the cat or dog shall remove the defecation immediately." **We have received a number of complaints with regard to Section 10(1) and would ask that you ensure, as a pet owner, you are complying.** Of particular note are areas such as the ball diamond, the soccer field, the parks and other public areas.
