AS THE OWNER/OPERATOR OF AN ATV PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- ATV's are not allowed to travel on any crown land or private property (this includes the rail right of way, school yards & churches) in town limits unless driving to or from the operator/owner's residence or place of business to the closest point of exit/entry from/to Town
- ♦ ATV's may only be operated between the hours of 9:00 am and 10:00 pm
- While driving to or from the boundary the speed on an ATV is restricted to 20 kph
- ♦ ATV's are not to drive on any lane or ditch which is used to convey water within the Town limits
- ↑ The All Terrain Vehicles Act of Saskatchewan has a number of additional legal requirements including proof of insurance, age, etc. Please refer to the Town of Osler website to find a copy of the Act or stop by the office and ask for a copy of both the Act and the Town's bylaw
