

BYLAW NO. 78-3

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF OSLER, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, TO REGULATE THE INSTALLATION OF PLUMBING WITHIN THE VILLAGE, SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT OF THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OSLER ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Regulations governing Plumbing and Drainage as set out under the provisions of The Public Health Act of the Province of Saskatchewan shall apply to govern plumbing and drainage and the disposal of sewage within the Village of Osler except as herein altered or added to.
2. The plumbing inspector shall be an inspector approved by the Regional Medical Health Officer.
3. No person shall construct, reconstruct, replace, alter or extend a plumbing system or part thereof until a permit to do so has been obtained from the village secretary.
4. No plumbing installation shall be connected to the municipal water supply until an inspection report certifying the installation is satisfactory has been deposited with the village clerk.
5. Upon coming into force of this bylaw:
 - (a) The village secretary shall be the only person authorized to issue a plumbing permit for the installation of plumbing within the Village of Osler.
 - (b) Permits shall be issued only to:
 - (i) A person in possession of a certificate of qualification as a journeyman plumber issued by the Department of Labour or a person or firm employing one or more such persons.
 - (ii) A person qualified to receive a permit under clause (1) of this subsection, or a person in possession of a second-class plumbers status certificate issued by the Department of Labour.
6. The fee for permits shall be:
 - (a) Subject to clause (b) \$10.00 for or up to the first 10 fixtures to be installed and one dollar for each additional fixture.
 - (b) \$5.00 for installation of two fixtures or less.
 - (c) \$5.00 for installation of private sewage works unless the plumbing within the building is installed by the same firm in which case a plumbing permit only is required.
 - (d) \$5.00 for a permanent connection of an existing plumbing system to a sewage works and/or waterworks.
7. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister of Public Health.
8. If any person fails, neglects or refuses to do anything which he is required to do by this bylaw, the Council may order the person in default to do such thing.

- 9. (1) A person who infringes any of the provisions of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00.
- (2) The imposition of such penalty for failure to comply with any of the provisions of this bylaw shall not relieve the person in default from carrying out the work therein mentioned, but he shall be liable on summary conviction to a further penalty of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$10.00 for each day after the first penalty is imposed until he has complied with the provisions of this bylaw.
