#### NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF ASSESSMENT ROLL TOWN OF OSLER

Assessment notices have been mailed to residents that have had a change. If you believe there is an error you may lodge an appeal no later than 5:00 pm on May 24th , 2022 . The appeal will be heard by the Board of Revision (Nor-Sask Board Services), of which you will be notified of a sitting date. The Board Secretary is Mike Ligtermoet, 642 Agnew Street, Prince Albert, SK. S6V 2P1 . The fee for an appeal is \$100.00 and will be refunded if the appeal is successful. Fees must accompany your appeal and must be filed with the Town of Osler, 228 Willow Drive, Box 190, Osler, SK S0K 3A0. Any person wishing to discuss the notice of assessment or potential appeal may contact our CAO, Lorie Foster at 306-239-2155.

Council will be finalizing the **Mill Rate** in the next few weeks and tax notices will likely be mailed sometime in mid June. As in previous years, there will be no discount on property taxes and, at this time, it is anticipated the penalty for non-payment of current year's taxes will remain unchanged at 1% per month beginning September 1st. This, of course, will need to be confirmed by Council following the setting of the Mill Rate. Check out the Town's website for updates in this regard.

### Reminders from Osler's Traffic Bylaw about Rec Vehicles

- Recreational Vehicles cannot be parked on the street for more than 24 consecutive hours (then must be moved to private property for 48 hours)
- \* Non-motorized Recreation Vehicles cannot be left on the street UNLESS they are attached to the vehicle designed to tow them
- \* Other licensed trailers (i.e. boat trailers, trailers used for hauling, etc.) cannot be parked on the street unless they are ATTACHED to the tow vehicle
