

**TOWN OF OSLER
BYLAW 2022-09
A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH
THE CURRENT MILL RATE**

The Council of the Town of Osler, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

PART I - SHORT TITLE

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Town of Osler Mill Rate Bylaw.

PART II – DEFINITIONS

2. In this Bylaw:

“**COUNCIL**” shall refer to the Council of the Town of Osler

“**MUNICIPALITY**” shall refer to the Town of Osler

“**PROPERTY**” shall mean a parcel of land on located within the boundaries of the Town of Osler and on which a building or buildings (commercial or residential) may or may not be situated, whether such buildings are occupied or unoccupied

PART III – PURPOSE

3. The purpose of this Bylaw is to identify the uniform mill rate as set by the Council of the Municipality and to be applied against all properties unless specifically exempted by Saskatchewan legislation or by a Policy or Bylaw of the Municipality.

PART IV – MILL RATE and TAX TOOLS

4. The Mill Rate for the Town of Osler shall be established at 8.20 Mills.
5. All taxable property is subject to any base tax or mill rate factor bylaw adopted by the Council of the Municipality.
6. The Education Mill Rate be levied in accordance with the annual rate(s) set out by the Province of Saskatchewan in consultation with the Ministry of Education, such advice being provided to the Municipality by the Provincial government.

PART V – REPEAL PREVIOUS BYLAW

7. Bylaw 2021-03 is hereby repealed.

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PART VI - COMING INTO FORCE AND EFFECT

8. The mill rate contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect and first be applied to the 2022 tax levy.

Read a first time this 31st day of May, 2022

Read a second time this 31st day of May, 2022

Read a third time and adopted this 31st day of May, 2022
