**Reminders from Osler's Traffic Bylaw
about Rec Vehicles**

- * Recreational Vehicles cannot be parked on the street for more than 24 consecutive hours (then must be moved to private property for 48 hours)
- * Non-motorized Recreation Vehicles cannot be left on the street UNLESS they are attached to the vehicle designed to tow them
- * Other licensed trailers (i.e. boat trailers, trailers used for hauling, etc.) cannot be parked on the street unless they are ATTACHED to the tow vehicle
