Meter Readings Every Other Month Starting in June

As outlined in Bylaw 2025-05: A Bylaw to Control and Regulate the Water and Wastewater Utilities Provided by the Town of Osler, we will be transitioning to meter readings every other month starting in June. This means readings will be taken every two months, rather than monthly.

Please submit your meter reading by the last day of the month when prompted. If a reading is not submitted, your usage will be estimated for that period. We will post specific dates for when to submit your readings on Facebook.
