PART I - PURPOSE

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend Bylaw 2012 – 15, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

- 1. **Table 6-11 Small Lot Residential** is amended by reducing the Minimum Site Width for from 12 metres to 10 metres, for the following uses:
 - Single detached dwellings
 - Adult day care

- Residential care facilities
- Bed and breakfast homes
- Day care centres and preschools
- 2. The Zoning District Map referred to in Section 7 Maps is amended by rezoning Parcel A, Plan 102043145 from R3-High Density Residential to R1A Small Lot Residential as shown on "Schedule A" which is attached to and forms a part of this bylaw.


