

**TOWN OF OSLER  
BYLAW 2022-10  
A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH  
MILL RATE FACTORS**

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The Council of the Town of Osler, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

**PART I - SHORT TITLE**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Town of Osler Mill Rate Factor Bylaw.

**PART II – DEFINITIONS**

2. In this Bylaw:

“**CAO**” or “**ADMINISTRATOR**” shall refer to the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Osler

“**COUNCIL**” shall refer to the Council of the Town of Osler

“**MUNICIPALITY**” shall refer to the Town of Osler

“**PROPERTY**” shall mean a parcel of land on located within the boundaries of the Town of Osler and on which a building or buildings (commercial or residential) may or may not be situated, whether such buildings are occupied or unoccupied

**PART III – PURPOSE**

3. The purpose of this Bylaw is to identify the mill rate factors(s) to be applied to the uniform mill rate levied against various property classes as set by the Council of the Municipality.

**PART IV – MILL RATE FACTORS**

Property Classification	Mill Rate Factor
Agriculture	1.5
Residential	1.0
Commercial & Industrial	1.6

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4. Where a property is classified within more than one property classification by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency, the base tax calculation shall be the higher of the applicable classes.

**PART VI – REPEAL PREVIOUS BYLAW**

5. Bylaw 2021-04 is hereby repealed.

**PART VII - COMING INTO FORCE AND EFFECT**

6. The mill rate factors contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day the bylaw is adopted by Council and shall first be applied to the 2022 tax levy.

Read a second time this 31<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2022

Read a third time and adopted this 31<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2022
